I continued to sell detectors and supplies from our house until 1993, then we opened up shop in PNS coins in Lancaster. Business was good for a few years but then the Buzzard from GPAA past away and business dropped off. We stayed in the shop for a couple of more years then decided to move the business back home where we are now. We now have more time to enjoy the important things in life, our family. 





Remember, as with the recycling collection, the proceeds from the sale of apparel are put back in the club to fund prizes and food at the outing.


