


1st Qtr. 2024 Scavenger Hunt

DESCRIPTION OF BONUS ITEM Barber Coins

The Barber coins consist of a dime, quarter, and half dollar designed by United States Bureau of the Mint Chief Engraver Charles E. Barber. They were minted between 1892 and 1916 though no half dollars were struck in the final year of the series.

But did you know the Liberty Head nickel, sometimes referred to as the "V" nickel, was also designed by Barber! In the early 1880's the United States Mint was looking to replace the "Shield" nickel and instructed Barber to prepare designs for the one-, three-, and five-cent pieces. Only the new five-cent piece was approved, and went into production in 1883 for the next thirty years. ***Wes Weathers***




